

## Buzz Bee's Map Game

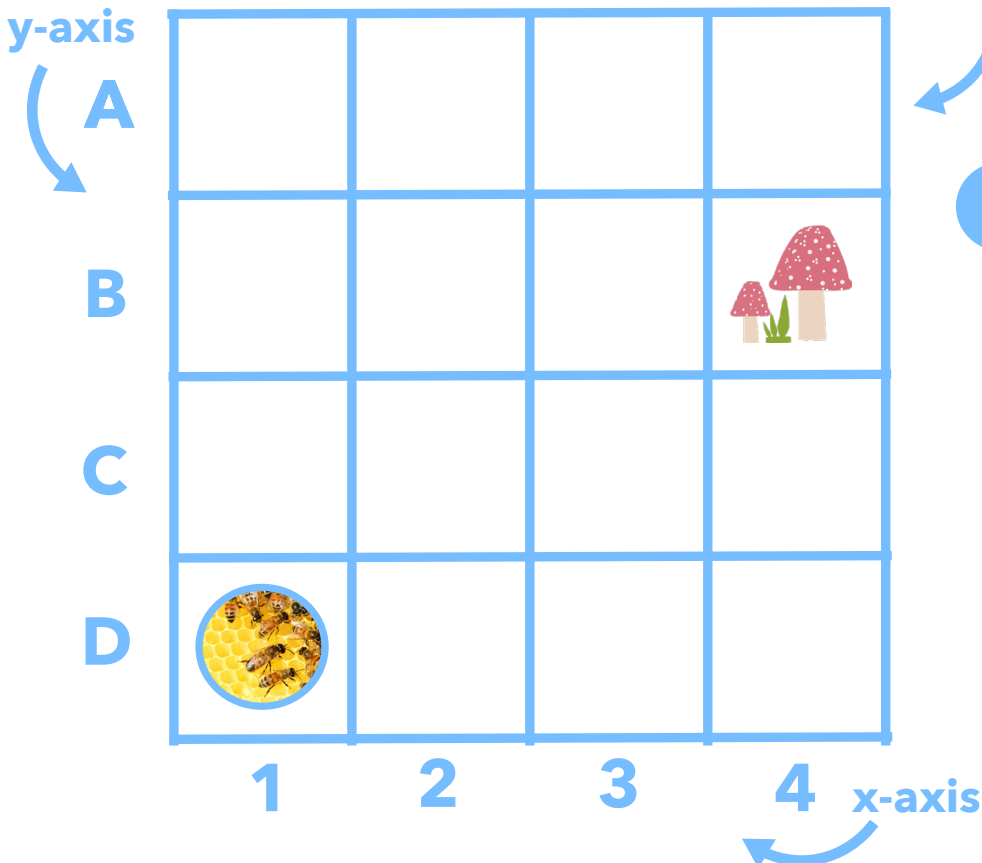
**Co-ordinates** are two numbers or letters on a grid that show the position of an object.

The horizontal axis is called the **x-axis** and the vertical axis is called the **y-axis**

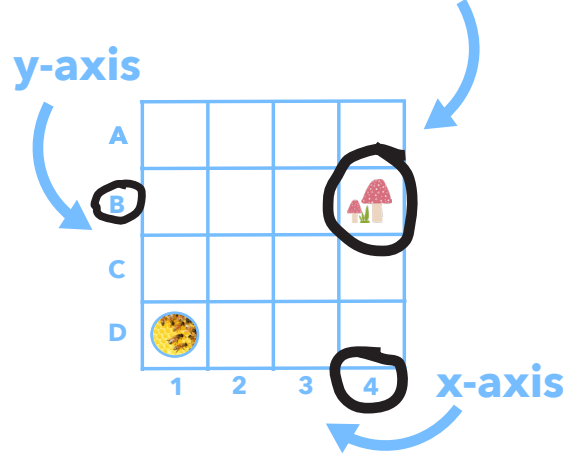
**Co-ordinates are always written with the x axis first and the y axis second, so in the example shown the co-ordinates of the mushrooms would be written: 4,B**

These are the co-ordinates showing the route Buzz Bee takes from his hive to the mushrooms:

**1,D 1,C 1,B 2,B 2,A 3,A 3,B 4,B**



### Example map grid



**1** Put a dot in each of the squares that match the co-ordinates.

**2** Draw the route on the grid by joining up the dots in straight lines.

Try making a grid of a room and work out the co-ordinates to get from one place to another- you could give the co-ordinates to a friend and see if they can find treasure you have hidden!
